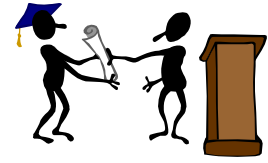
Support Your Halls High PTSO

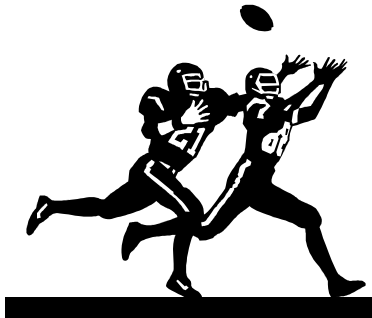
