The Tennessee Scholars initiative is a course of study that encourages students to take more demanding classes in high school. This program better prepares students to enter a technical school, a community college, a university, or the workforce.

Students must meet the following requirements in order to graduate as a Tennessee Scholar:

- 4 English Courses
- 4 Mathematics Courses (Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II and one higher level math)
- 3 Science Courses (Biology and two other lab sciences)
- 3 Social Studies Courses (Government/Economics, U.S. History, etc.)
- 2 World Language Courses (Same language) OR 2 Technical Courses (Same cluster)
- 1 Advanced Placement Course
- 1 Wellness Course
- 1 Business/Computer Course

Additional Expectations:

- GPA of 2.5 or higher overall
- 95% attendance
- Pass all Gateway Exams
- No Out-of-School suspensions
- 20 Hours of Community Service
